IRD Duhallow's Raptor LIFE Project

Supported by the LIFE Financial Instrument of the European Community

The **RaptorLife** team have been busy this month tackling the invasive plant species Japanese Knotweed along its main vector routes - roadways and rivers in the Duhallow region and the project area. The main method of dispersal is by spreading rhizomes (underground stems). Many infestations are the result of mechanical cutting and/or transport of soil containing rhizome fragments. Once established it quickly spreads out-competing our native flora and degrading the stability of our river banks. The RaptorLIFE team are treating Knotweed along the road and river routes by spraying and injecting herbicide directly into stems. If you would like further information on this plant or would like to report a sighting, please contact 029-60633. RaptorLIFE continues to remove Himalayan Balsam along river routes. This is a delicate but arduous task for our team as most plants have formed fully developed seed heads close to popping. The team are physically removing the seed heads for disposal off-site to prevent further spread. Sediment and macro-invertebrate sampling has started at 15 of our project sites located along the Upper Blackwater River and River Araglin. These sites have been fenced off to prevent cattle access to the river with the aim to improve vegetation recovery, bank stabilization and water quality. Macro-invertebrate sampling involves capturing and identifying aquatic insects, bugs and larvae that have different tolerances to water pollution. They indicate the water quality of that site and allow our team to assess whether or not measures put in place by our team are achieving their objective to improve the river habitat quality for our project species, the Brook Lamprey and Atlantic Salmon
