## IRD Duhallow's Raptor LIFE Project Supported by the LIFE Financial Instrument of the European Community

It has been extremely busy for all our fieldworkers as this is the optimum time for Japanese Knotweed treatment. To date, the project has treated over 500 knotweed stands along the roads and riverbanks in the project area. This work was undertaken in both 2016 and 2017, and will be repeated in 2018. We are currently undertaking small mammal surveys on our project farms to provide information on the effectiveness of our habitat management work to increase the amount of prey available to Hen harrier and other raptors.

A Controlled Burning Workshop will take place in Millstreet Country Park on Wednesday 22nd November, 2017. The workshop is organised in conjunction with the Forest Service, Teagasc, and the Department of Agriculture, Food and Marine.
