The Warmer Homes Scheme

Free Insulation Service: Eligibility criteria expanded to include One Parent Family Payment. If you are in receipt of one of the following payments, you may be eligible to receive insulation services free of charge: **Fuel Allowance or One Parent Family Payment or Family Income Supplement or Jobseekers Allowance** (for more than 6 months and have children under 7 years of age). Houses must be owner occupied and constructed before 2006.

Home Incentive Scheme: There are home insulation grants available through the SEAI for all homeowners whose properties were constructed prior to 2006. Works carried out include attic and cavity wall insulation. Grants of up to €923 are available to qualifying households. IRD Duhallow's Raptor LIFE Project Supported by the LIFE Financial Instrument of the European Community

RaptorLIFE have wrapped up all invasive species work for the year. We finished our second year of herbicide treatment of roadside knotweed with good levels of dieback recorded after the treatment in 2016. We have far exceeded our targets, with well over 100km of roadside and 57km of riverbank treated. We also treated giant rhubarb and prickly heath in 2017. The project has finished a third year of removing Himalayan balsam from an 80.2km stretch of riverbank

(Upper Blackwater and Owentaraglin).

Ongoing habitat restoration work on our project farms include the planting of new and infilling of existing hedgerows. The hedgerow provides shelter from the elements, safety from predators and is a supply of food. Hedgerows are also nature's motorways, they're the means by which small mammals, insects, butterflies, plants and even birds move throughout the land. Our AfterLIFE commitments to the completed DuhallowLIFE project are ongoing. We are currently in the midst of maintenance work to otter holts, log piles and dipper nests.
